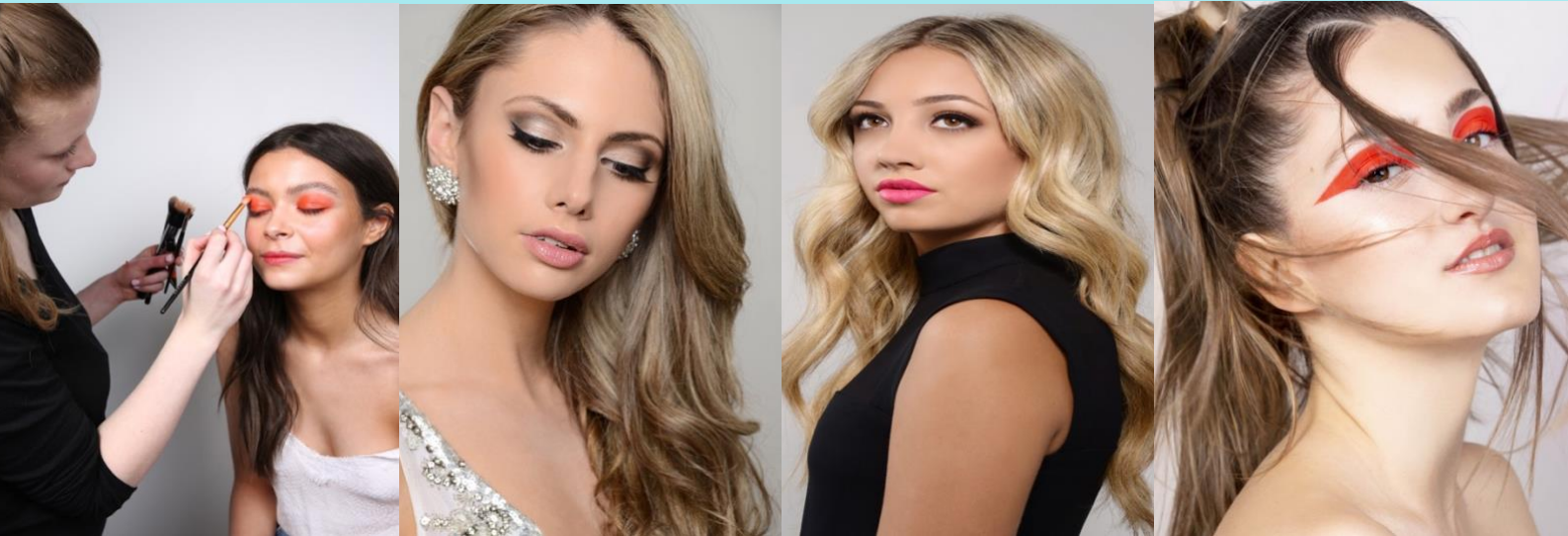

APPLICATION PROCESS

To apply, complete the online Application Form & submit it to info@mediamakeup.com.au. If you have left high school within the last 2 years, please provide a copy of the most recent school report.

The application must have all questions answered & the relevant documents attached. Once your application has been received, you will be contacted for an interview at the Academy.

Please download & read the Learners Handbook prior to the interview & bring it with you, as there are forms that need to be completed. If you are under 18, a guardian will need to attend the interview.

Prior to the interview, we ask that you arrive 15 minutes early to complete a short questionnaire. This will help us to better understand your ability to undertake the qualification that you are applying for.

At the interview, the content & activities of the course & any Incidental Expenses or Fees & Charges will be explained. Policies and Procedures of the Academy will be discussed and the prospective learner's ability to undertake the course will be assessed.

If accepted into the course, a deposit is required & payment will be due at this time. A confirmation of enrolment will be received to confirm course placement.
